What is exposed?

A research-based program designed to educate college-aged women on the benefits of sexual risk avoidance, the risk of engaging in the college hook-up culture, and options regarding an unplanned pregnancy.

What material is covered in the program?

All material covered will be cited from credible sources including scholarly journals, empirically-based studies, Centers for Disease Control statistics, medical professionals, etc.

- Sexual Risk Avoidance
- Researched-based information defining and examining the college campus hook-up culture.
- Options regarding an unplanned pregnancy, including facts about parenting, abortion, and adoption.

Who is the target audience?

This program is specifically designed for college-aged women, ideally freshman women who are new to a university. Exposed is a great program for the following venues:
